What we do

The ILSA Gateway is a valuable resource for studying education on a global scale. It provides information about and from international large-scale assessments (ILSAs) in education, which are studies that investigate various aspects of education and educational achievement in multiple countries. Approximately 70% of the countries in the world participate in ILSAs. ILSAs cover a range of populations, from pre-primary to post-secondary and investigate a variety of domains, including mathematics, science, reading, civics, computer and information literacy, and various others.

They are conducted by a number of organizations, including CONFEMEN (PASEC), the IDB (PRIDI), IEA (ICCS, ICILS, PIRLS, TEDS-M, and TIMSS), IEA/UNESCO (REDS), OECD (IELS, PIAAC, PISA, TALIS, and TALIS Starting Strong), SACMEQ (SACMEQ III, SACMEQ IV), SEAMEO/UNICEF (SEA-PLM), UNESCO (ERCE), and the World Bank (STEP). The Gateway allows users to explore and navigate these ILSAs by study, theme, or through a search function.

Initiators and directors, funding and management, contact details, authors
